## PERFORMANCE NOTES

For proper balance, the string quartet may require amplification. A double quartet or string ensemble is reccomended.
Three (3) piano parts are included: an orchestral part, to be played with the full ensemble; a rehearsal piano, for working with the choir; and a concert version, which is a standalone arrangement suitable for situations where only part or none of the large ensemble is available.

The men's choir should divide into three groups: GROUP A (6-12 members), GROUP B ( $12-24$ members), and GROUP C ( $24+$ members). From mm. I-29, GROUP A sings Leads I-3, while GROUP B sings the TTBB parts. Group C rests. Then, from mm. 29 until the end, groups A and B join on the lead parts, while GROUP C sings the TTBB parts. Alternatively, for a simpler arrangement, the mens choir can be divided into two groups, one small and one large. The small group sings Leads I-3 and the large group sings the TTBB parts.
